GUN TESTS GRADE: A-

This gun has it all—porting, extended choke tubes, fiber-optic sights, the proper balance for sporting clays, and a main-event 12-gauge feel in a 20-gauge package. This fell short of an A rank because it came with three choke tubes and no hard case.

The buttstock from wrist top to butt pad felt full size, which we liked. The pistol grip swept away and back from the trigger guard, allowing for various hand placements. Few will feel this gun is sized wrong.



We liked the modern good looks of the Cynergy. With subtle angles at the receiver edges, trigger guard, fore-end back edge, and the top lever, this gun had an appearance that echoed the way it handled. Another plus—Browning kept the embellishments to a minimum.



Of the three, the Cynergy was the only one with ported barrels, a bonus when shooting heavier loads. It also came with extended choke tubes, and it was the only one of our three test guns that was provided with a full set of fiber-optic sight pins. As far as accessories go, this gun lacked only a hard case, in our view.
