While the shotgun was the least expensive of the group, we could find no fault in its ability to serve as an effective self-defense tool.

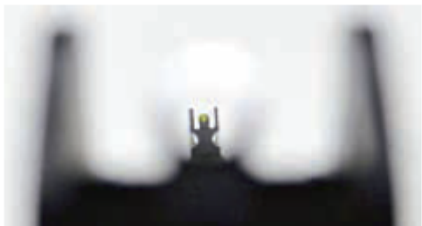
A no-frills, basic stock on the Stevens provided good recoil relief while the grooved full length pistol grip was not as deep as the Benelli, but allowed for a steady and secure hold during our range tests.



The extra long forearm featuring grooved ridges was nearly identical to the one on the higher priced Benelli and offered comfortable and effective control of the firearm during shooting tests.



Very clear and visible, we preferred the Ghost Ring sight set up on the Stevens over all of the other test models and found it helped allow for very good patterning performance.



The much smaller action release lever on the back of the Stevens trigger guard, compared with the other test shotguns, caused us a little concern at first, but we encountered no problems when engaging the button during our firing tests.
